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## SECTION 7 — FIRST AID MEASURES

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## SECTION 8 — PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

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### STEPS TO BE TAKEN

**IF MATERIAL IS SPILLED OR RELEASED:** Dispense sand, sawdust, or vermiculite. Collect and place in plastic waste container. Wash area thoroughly with water. Flush small amounts. (biodegradable)

**WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD:** Use sanitary landfill disposal, (not a hazardous waste) according to federal, state and local regulations. (RCRA; subtitle D)

### PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN HANDLING AND STORAGE:

Do not mix with other chemicals. Avoid prolonged contact. Store away from heat. Keep from freezing, Store above 40°F.

### OTHER PRECAUTIONS:

Store in secure area. Avoid food or feed contamination. Avoid prolonged inhalation of vapors. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

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**RESPIRATORY PROTECTION:** Not normally required with good ventilation.
